

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-1

AN ORDINANCE OF BRIDGETON TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING SECTION 3.01 OF THE BRIDGETON TOWNSHIP FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE 2015-1 TO CHANGE THE FLOODPLAIN ADMINISTRATOR AND ADDING A PROVISION REQUIRING COMPLIANCE WITH ALL TOWNSHIP PERMITS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Bridgeton Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

ARTICLE I.

- a. Section 3.01 of Ordinance 2015-1, (the “Bridgeton Township Floodplain Management Ordinance”) Designation of the Floodplain Administrator is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

“The Board of Supervisors shall annually appoint the Township Zoning Officer, or other qualified person, as the Floodplain Administrator to administer and enforce this Ordinance and as is referred to herein as the Floodplain Administrator.

In the absence of the designated Floodplain Administrator, the Floodplain Administrator duties are to be fulfilled by the the Township Engineer.”

- b. The Bridgeton Township Floodplain Management Ordinance is further amended to add the following provision:

“Section 3.13. Nothing herein shall relieve or waive the requirements of an applicant to comply with all other permit requirements of the Township applicable to the project proposed pursuant to of Section 3.04.A.6.”

ARTICLE II Repealer

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE III. Severability

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or part of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of

Bridgeton Township, that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof had not been included therein.

ARTICLE IV. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption
